



Go Read / Boom Reader Useful Guide:

1. Visit: [BoomReader – The Digital Reading Record \(go-read.co.uk\)](https://go-read.co.uk/) <https://go-read.co.uk/>
2. In the top right-hand corner, there is a link to 'Login'. Press on this. Click on 'Pupils'. Then type in our 'School Code'. Our School Code is: **85293**.






3. It will then ask for your child's PIN code. This is unique to your child and can be found on the additional log in information sheet attached.




4. Press 'Launch' on Boom Reader / Go Read.



5. This will take you to your child's home screen, whereby you will see which book they have been set to read. In the example below, you will see the book highlighted below: 'Old McDonald'.



6. You can now click on the book to record what pages your child has read and what comments you or your child would like to make about the book, or about the progress your child has made. This is a vital communication tool between home and school, so please use this. Press 'Add Reading Log' to publish the record of your child's reading. You are encouraged to record other reading material read at home under the 'New Book' link too! Remember, it is important to read for pleasure and to read a wide range of reading materials. Therefore, a balance between reading your own reading material and the scheme books sent home is essential.




7. When adding your own books, you can do one of the following:


-Search for your book to see whether it is already in the 'Boom Reader' library.

-Scan your book and see whether a camera app can find your book quickly for you to add.

-Click on the 'Add New Book' link under your child's avatar. This will enable you to add entries for the reading materials that you engage with at home which are not in the 'Boom Reader' library, such as magazines, newspapers, comics, annuals, etc.



8. We will then be able to see your reading comments in our own 'Teacher' section of the website. We will also be able to respond back to you and add our own comments from school. This will appear within the book entries under the 'Reading Log History'. You will also notice 'Boom! Gems awarded', which your child can collect for each time an entry has been recorded at school and at home. This helps to track and reward your child's efforts and links to the 'Reading Rainbow' in school. More information about the 'Reading Rainbow' is included in your main letter.
