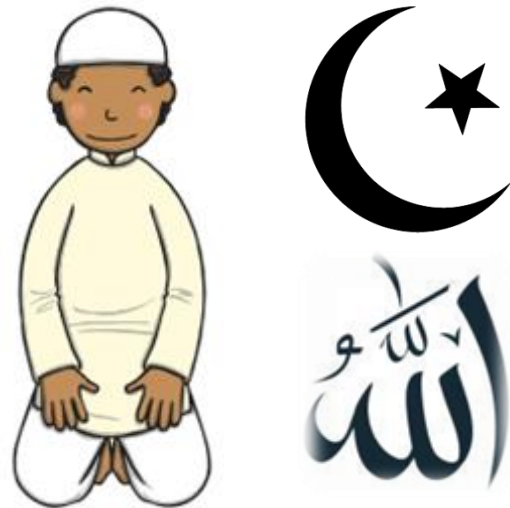
We are learning to explain what commitment means to us and to Muslims by knowing about how Muslims pray 5 times a day.



Key objectives








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| To explain how it felt to have to stop doing something to reach the target we had set.        |
